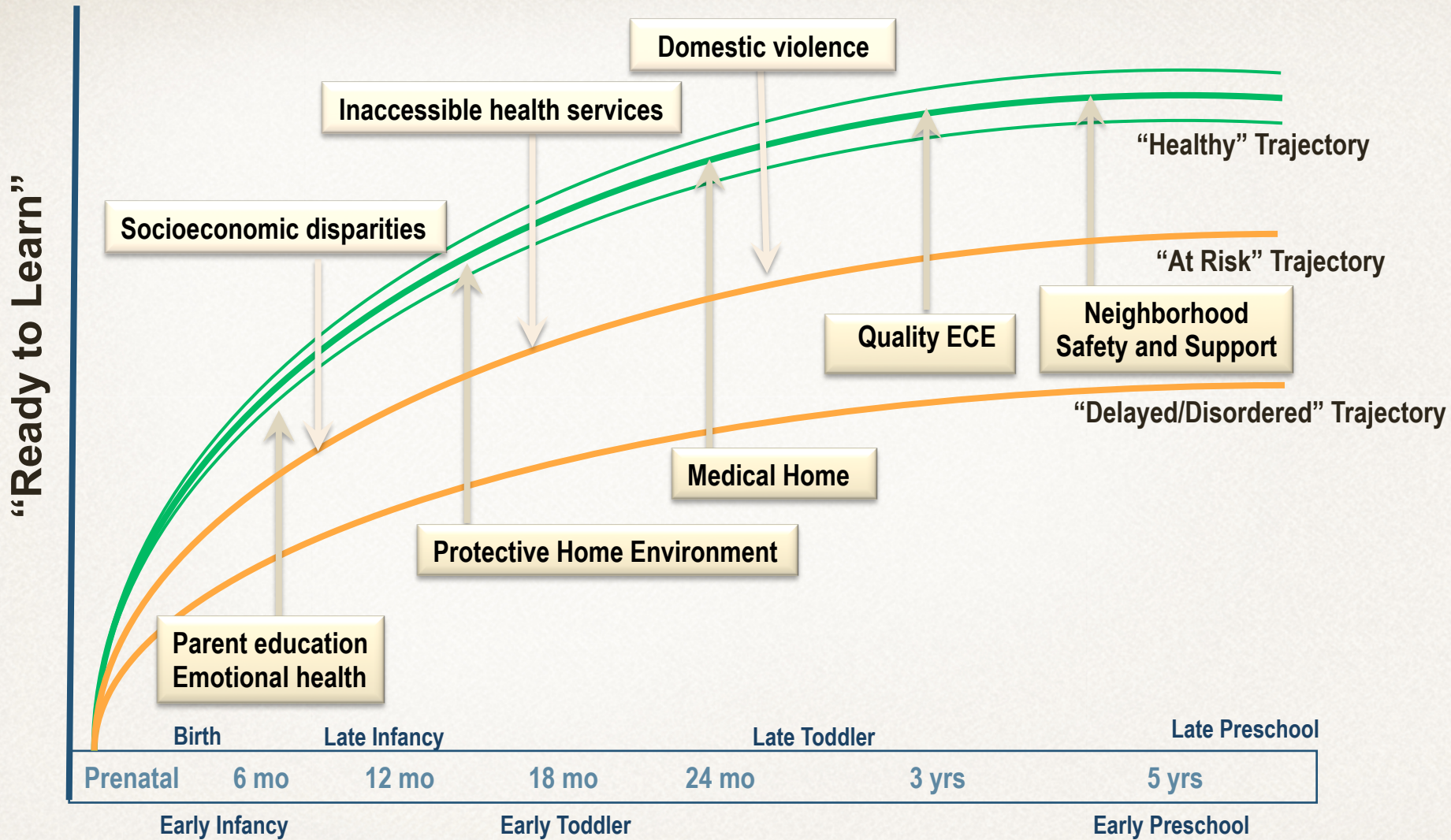


# ODAS-ECD's Goals

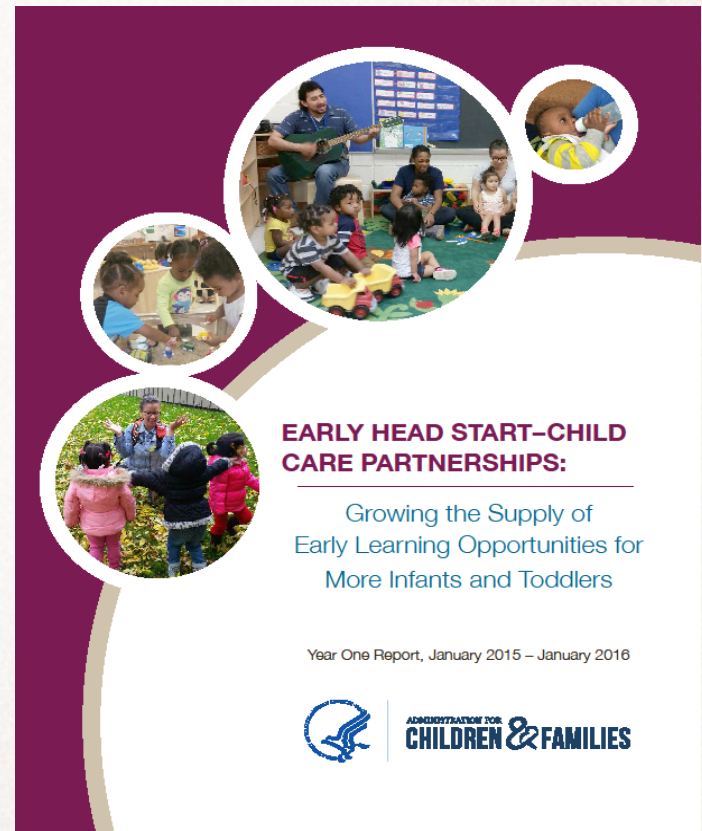

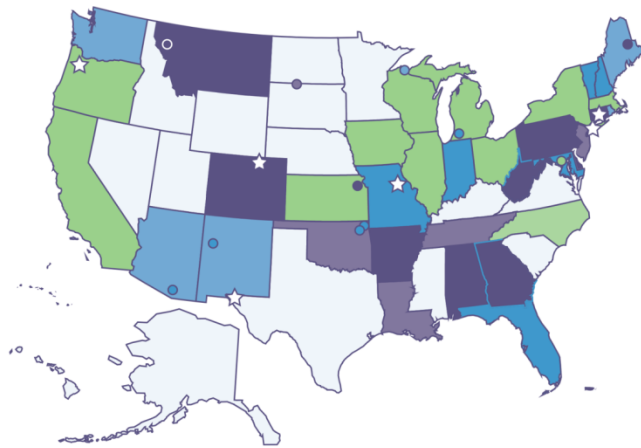
# HRSA Early Childhood Comprehensive Systems Impact Grants

- Achieve greater collective impact in early childhood systems building at state, county, and community levels
- Use two generation approaches to improve population-based outcomes in child developmental health and family well-being
  - Participate in Collaborative Innovation and Improvement Networks
  - Develop and adopt core sets of indicators to measure system processes and outcome indicators
  - Test systems change innovations, develop spread strategies, and adopt policies for sustainability

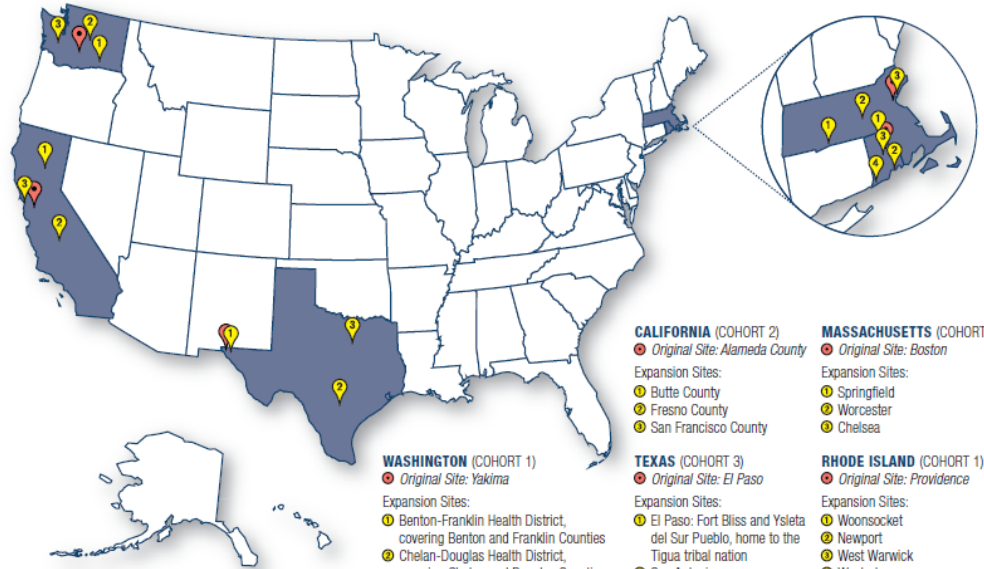

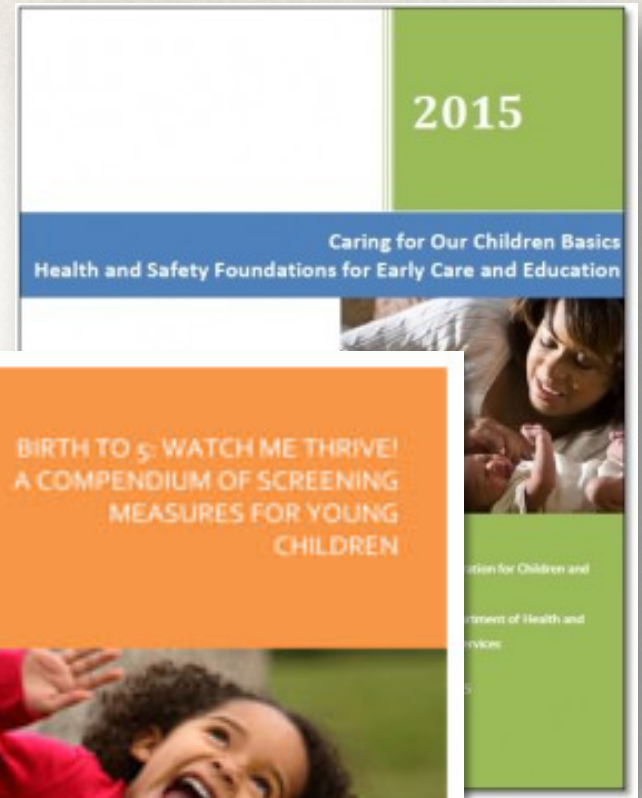

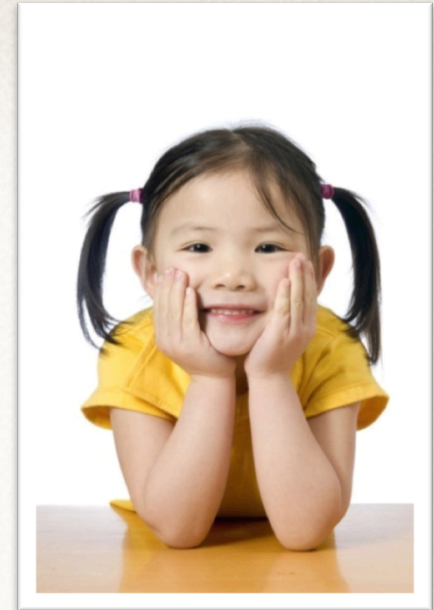
