\* The CMS enrollment data does not provide a breakdown of child enrollment for Arizona, the District of Columbia, and Tennessee. Data for those states was collected from state sources. All data is subject to retroactive changes, and therefore, may not match prior blogs and reports.

Arizona releases quarterly data. January data is substituted for December data in 2017 and 2018 and April 2019 data is substituted for March 2019.

In Tennessee, December CHIP 2017 data is not available. January 2018 data is substituted for December 2017 for both Medicaid and CHIP in this analysis.

Tennessee data has been revised to include unborn child enrollment to align with CMS enrollment data in other states.
