Arizona releases quarterly data. January data is substituted for December data in 2017 and 2018 and May 2019 data is substituted for April 2019. In Tennessee represented, December CHIP 2017 data is not available, January 2018 for both Medicaid and CHIP is used in this analysis. DC has not released their May 2019 enrollment data, so April 2019 was used instead.
